Summer Academy Parking Regulations

1. Display the **PARKING PERMIT** on the driver's side of the dash of your car.
2. Park only in the designated lot.
3. Do not drive recklessly or over 5 miles per hour on campus.
4. Do not sit in your car nor allow others to do so while parked on school property.
5. Do not go to the parking lot nor leave school property during school hours without administrative approval.
6. Do not take other students illegally off school grounds.
7. Do not use/bring alcohol beverages, drugs, weapons or tobacco products on school grounds.
8. Students must not loan a vehicle to another student to enter or leave school grounds.
9. Vehicles may be searched at any time. Any items which violate school regulations or state law will be confiscated.
10. The school authorities are not liable for damage or loss due to vandalism, theft, etc. Lock your vehicle!
11. Students are not to pull into the line of buses as they leave school grounds.
12. Cleanliness of the parking lot is the responsibility of the student users.
13. **Students must be in good standing in all areas of the Summer Academy Program to maintain parking privilege.**
14. Violation of any of the above rules will result in loss of parking privilege for the remainder of Summer Academy.
NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR WITHDRAWN PARKING PRIVILEGES.
15. Tardies to Summer Academy may result in loss of parking permit without a refund of parking fees and/or dismissal from Summer Academy without a refund of parking fees.
16. Students should not loiter in the parking lot.

Parking at the Summer Academy Program is a privilege and should be taken very seriously. Be sure that you do everything you can to protect your privilege and make your parking lot a safe environment.
