Continuity of Learning

Learning Modules for middle school and high school students will be available in Aspen Monday morning. Report Cards

Student report cards were published on Aspen today. These grades will stay posted though May 15. Students and families are encouraged to contact their teachers if they have questions about quarter 3 grades and would like an opportunity to improve a quarter 3 course grade.

- call 757-527-4819 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday and provide the following information:
 - the email address the parent/guardian used when they registered their student
 - the student's first, middle and last name
 - the parent's first and last name
- view the report card with their student through their student account
- contact the school and request a printed copy be mailed
