New School Immunizations Required

Effective July 1, 2021, the following immunizations are required for children attending school in Virginia:



Hepatitis A (HAV) Vaccine | Pre-K & Kindergarten

Minimum of 2 doses of Hepatitis A vaccine for kindergarten and Pre-K students only.

Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) Vaccine | Grade 7

A booster dose of Tdap vaccine is required for all students entering grade 7.

Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY) Vaccine | Grade 7 & 12

2 doses are required, one before starting grade 7 and another before starting grade 12.

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine | Grade 7

A complete series of **2 doses** of HPV vaccine is required for students entering the **7th grade**. The first dose shall be administered before the child enters the 7th grade. After reviewing educational materials approved by the Board of Health, the parent or guardian, at the parents or guardians sole discretion, may elect for the child not to receive the HPV vaccine.
