Original Credit:

Full year coursework totaling 140 instructional hours of asynchronous instruction, assignments, and both formative and summative assessments (*approximately 7 hours of daily work Monday – Friday*)

For students who have:

- Not taken the course before
- Taken the course before, earned credit, but would like to take it again to earn a higher final grade
- Taken the course and formally omitted the course from their transcript (*current middle school students only*)

Recovery Credit:

Abbreviated coursework totaling 70 instructional hours of asynchronous instruction and summative assessments (*approximately 4 hours of daily work Monday – Friday*)

For students who have:

- Completed the traditional 140 seat hours and have a final grade of F on their transcript for the course
- Credit recovery is not available for World Languages
